BOYS' TOWN HOME CHARITY GOLF RAFFLES COUNTRY CLUB, 17 JULY 2007

Boys' Town Home (BTH) is a Catholic institution set up by the Brothers of St Gabriel in 1948. BTH offers residential care to disadvantaged boys and provides them an environment that is conducive to their education and development so that they can be socially integrated into society. It admits boys between the ages of 12 and 17 who come mainly from financially and socially challenged families; and also boys who have behaviour difficulties.

With the challenges posed by an ever-changing society, the relevance of BTH has only increased. Despite our continued economic success, the number of dysfunctional families in Singapore has increased.

We are experiencing an increase in the number of boys coming to us. Over the last 6 decades, we estimate that 3100 boys have benefited from the mission of BTH. Our current enrolment is 60 and we are planning for an increase to 100 to meet the demand.

We have always depended on the generosity of the public to fund this mission. As it costs about \$1100 per month to provide for each boy (board lodging and staff costs form the bulk of expenses), we will have to raise more donations this year to fulfill our objective. For this, we appeal to your kind generosity.

A Charity Golf Tournament, a first for BTH, will be held to raise the additional funds needed. Our Guest-of-Honour is Mr. Lim Boon Heng, Minister in the Prime Minister's Office. To add a spin to the event, we will also be inviting a mystery guest. The contribution for each flight of four will be as follows:

Gold	\$10,000/flight
Silver	\$5,000 /flight
For individuals	\$1,000/slot

Donors will be entitled to a Tax Deduction for every dollar donated.

If you are not a golfer, we would also appreciate any donation, in cash or kind you make towards the event.

As we are planning to make this Charity Golf an annual event, the winner of the tournament will have his name engraved onto the Challenge Cup.

We hope you will help us make this occasion a success so that our boys can be given a chance to do well in life. Please provide your details on the following page.

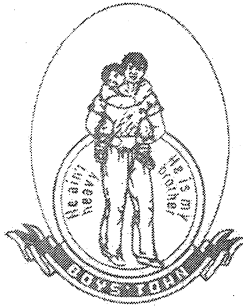
